Commonwealth of Virginia be, and hereby is, SUSPENDED. It is further ORDERED that a

formal hearing be convened forthwith to receive and act upon evidence in this cause, and that the

Executive Director of the Board shall be authorized to execute this Order-and all other documents,

notices and Orders on behalf of the Board necessary to bring this matter to hearing.

Upon entry of this Order of Summary Suspension, the license of Brian T. Donohue, D.V.M.,

will be recorded as suspended and no longer current.

Pursuant to § 2.2-4023 and § 54.1-2400.2 F of the Code, the signed original of this Order

shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be

made available for public inspection or copying on request.
